If approved by California voters on November 3rd, it will help accelerate development of treatments and achieve cures for chronic [diseases and conditions](#) including cancer, Alzheimer’s, diabetes, heart disease, lower respiratory diseases, spinal cord injuries, blindness, multiple sclerosis, HIV/AIDS, kidney disease, infectious diseases like [COVID-19](#), and many others.

Proposition 14 will continue to build on the successes of California’s initial investment in stem cell research through [Proposition 71](#), passed in 2004. Since then, the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine (CIRM), a statewide stem cell research and therapy funding institute, has advanced research and therapy development for more than 75 diseases and conditions and 90+ clinical trials with more than 4,000 patients enrolled or expected to be enrolled throughout the state. As you can see, CIRM has made a great deal of progress since 2004, but there is still so much more work to be done. If we fail to pass Proposition 14, vital research and therapies will come to a halt, delaying lifesaving and life-changing treatments for years or decades.
